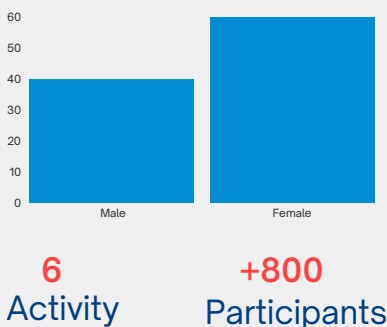
Highlights

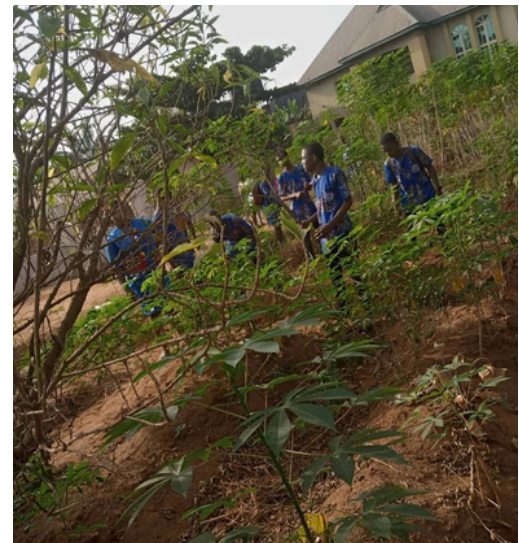

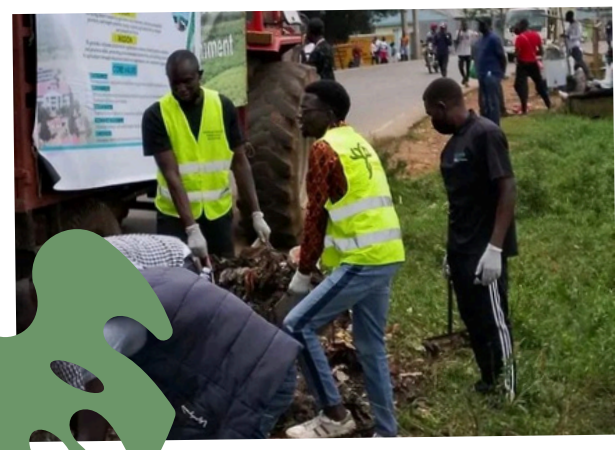

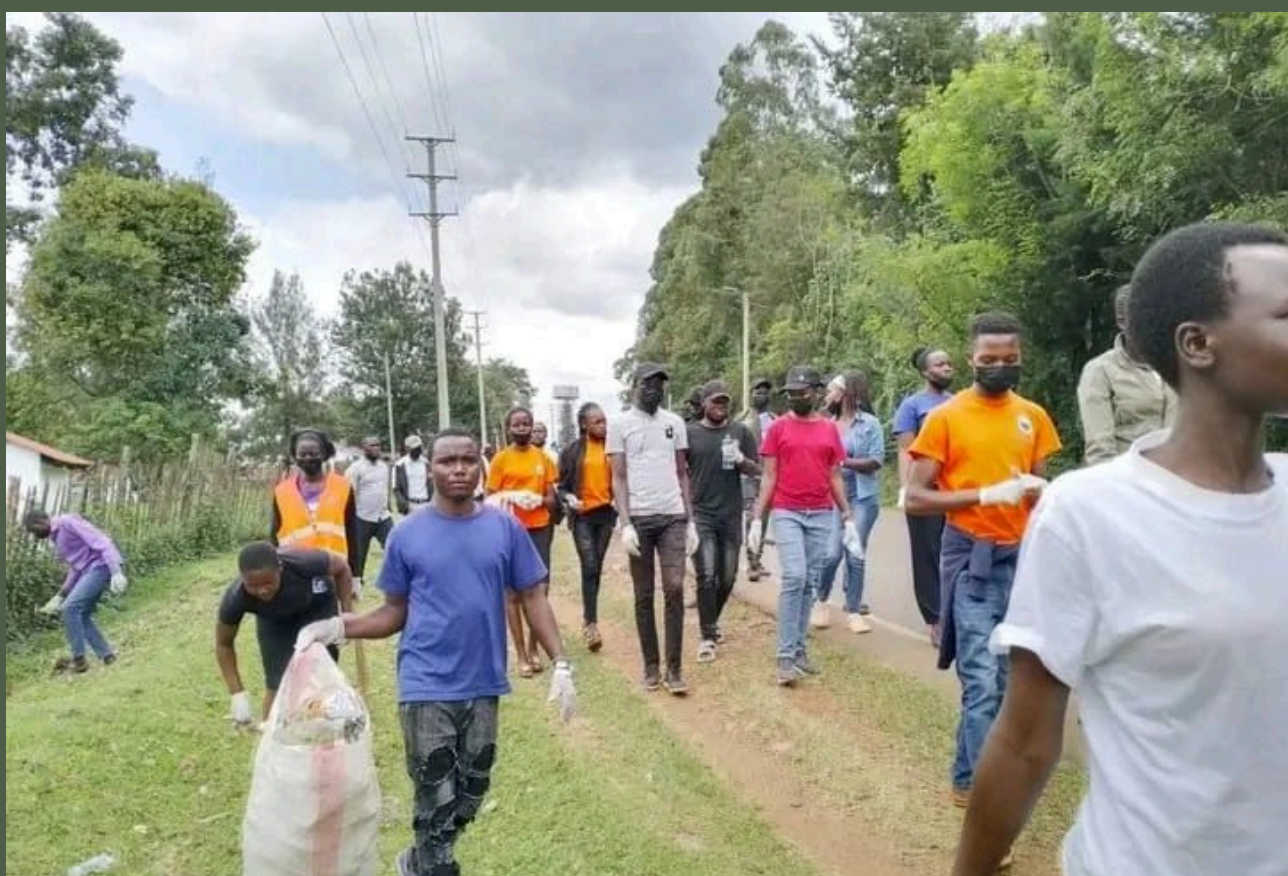


Njoro Precious Schools Kenya, in collaboration with local women's groups, and youth, came together for an inspiring environmental initiative planting of 3000 trees and cleanings
