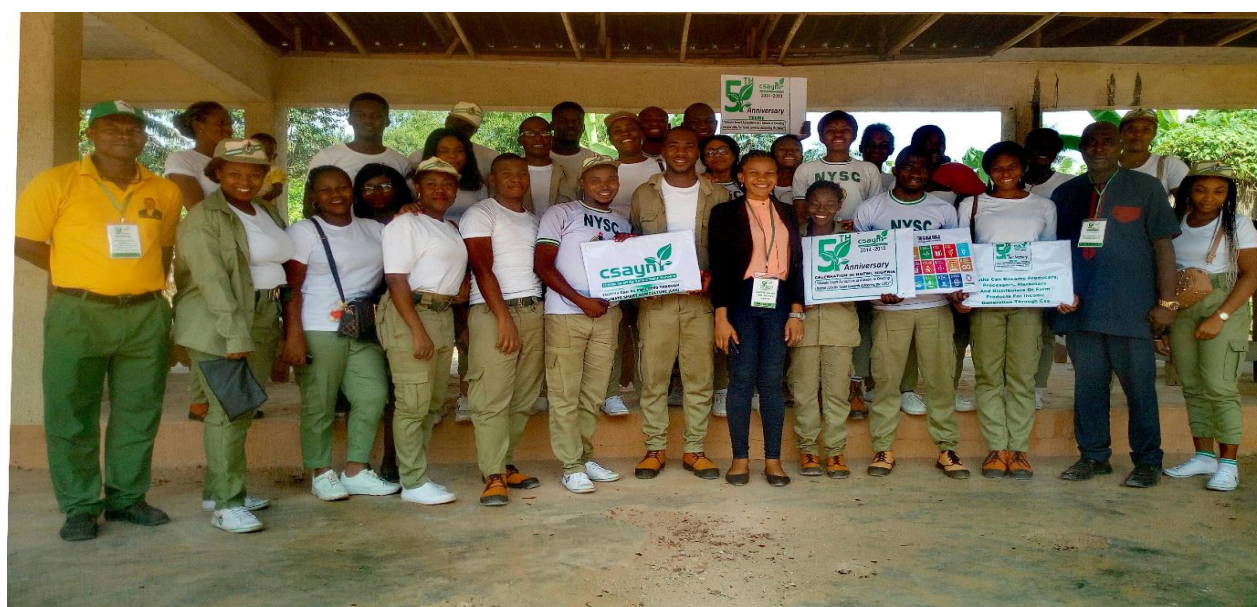

Descriptions of the Programme/Activities:

A workshop was convened in the Domboshava area of Goromonzi North District, a peri urban community 40 km from the capital city, Harare. The thrust of the workshop was to concretise the community of the dangers imposed by climate change on their livelihoods as well as celebrating the 5th anniversary of CSAYN, in conjunction with other CSAYN fellows dotted across the globe.

Three facilitators from CSAYN Zimbabwe presented varying topics from background of Climate change, founding of CSAYN, SDGs, Conservation Agriculture as well as Business Opportunities in Agriculture under Climate Change. The Culture trust patron also underlined the need to practice permaculture as a long term solution to affordable, profitable and sustainable way of growing crops and shared experiences, activities and lessons learnt over the years. The approach of the facilitators involved participatory way that enabled the subject to query on unfamiliar concepts and proffer solutions to existing problems. A wide array of comprehensive measures were shared with the farmers on how to adopt good agricultural practices in light of impending drought in Zimbabwe.

The CSAYN Global Founder, Divine's speech highlighted the importance of close cooperation between CSAYN and other organisations that have a shared goal with CSAYN, Mr. Shingie Maponga read the speech to the surprise audience who could not believe that two countries in different parts of the continent could actually have so much in common.

A tree planting ceremony concluded the day's activities where all the CSAYN facilitators, Nyasha, Shingie and Taurai planted exotic fruit trees.

Key achievements:

Drawing up support around the Domboshava area in such a short notice highlighted the importance placed on Climate change by communities that are predominantly agro-based. More women than men participated in the programme and this could be viewed as part of women empowerment and an achievement that could actually be accounted as part of gender equality promotion.

Key challenges:

The county is enduring the worst drought induced economic recession in a decade. The long distances covered by participants to the workshop means an added cost to them. Lower turnout that projected could be attributed to high transport costs to the venue.

The hosting of the workshop was also at the benevolence of the 6 CSAYN members who made monetary contributions to foot the refreshments and to cater for their transport costs to and from the venue.
